THE MAYOR CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:00 PM.

PRESENT AT THIS MEETING WERE: MAYOR STEPHEN SANDERS, BARBARA ADLER, CAMERON SHAW, AARON HOGUE, CHARLES RAINES, RONDA FRANKS, CHIEF MICHAEL CARTER, ZACHARY HOFFMAN, CHRIS FOLEY AND JUDGE JACKIE FREELAND. DARRELL STEVENSON WAS ABSENT.

DISCUSS AND ACT UPON WHO WILL BE THE "MAYOR PRO-TEM"

**CAMERON** NOMINATED BARBARA ADLERAS MAYOR PRO- TEM **AARON** MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE NOMINATION FOR BARBARA ADLER TO BE MAYOR PRO-TEM. **CAMERON** SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR MOTION PASSED. DISCUSS AND ACT UPON THE **YEARLY NEWS PAPER** TO PUBLISH ITEMS IN.

**AARON** MADE A MOTION TO KEEP CORSICANA DAILY SUN AS THE OFFICAL NEWSPAPER. **BARBARA** SECONDED THE MOTION . ALL IN FAVOR MOTION PASSED.

POLICE DEPT REPORT.

CHIEF CARTER GAVE THE MONTHLY REPORT. DISCUSS AND POSSIBLY ACT UPON **REVISING THE USE OF HOLIDAY** /**FLOAT TIME**. **AARON** MADE A MOTION TO LET THE FLOAT TIME ACCUMALATE BUT MUST BE ALL USED BY 12/31 OF EACH YEAR AND WE NEED TO KEEP A RECORD OF THE TIME ACCUMALATED AND USED. **CHARLES** SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL IN FAVOR. MOTION PASSED.

DISCUSS AND POSSIBLY AT UPON **ROBERT KEMP WORKING AS PART TIME** WHEN HE IS DONE WITH HIS MILITARY DUTY. TO BE DISCUSSED AND POSSIBLY ACTED UPON **AMENDING BUDGET**. **BARBARA** MADE A MOTION FOR RONDA TO FIGURE HOW MUCH THE SALARY WOULD BE FOR ROBERT KEMP SO WE WOULD KNOW MORE ABOUT THE BUDGET AND PUT IT ON THE JULY AGENDA. **AARON** SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR MOTION PASSED.

WATER/SEWER REPORT CHRIS FOLEY GAVE THE REPORT. THE MAYOR REPORTED THAT THE TRAILOR CHRIS HAD WANTED FORTHE NEW ZERO TURN WAS TO SMALL ANDTO **RE-DO OUR 16" TRAILOR WOULD COST APPROXIMATELY \$700.00 BARBARA** MADE A MOTION TO RE-DO 16" TRAILOR. **AARON** SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR MOTION PASSED.

**BARBARA** ASKED CHRIS TO GET A QUOTE FOR A 40" CONTAINER INSTEAD OF BUYING A PORTABLE BUILDING AND TO PUT ON JULY AGENDA WITH THE COST BEING SPLIT BETWEEN WATER/SEWER AND GENERAL FUND.

CHRIS REPORTED THAT TO PURCHASE ALL **GALVANIZED POLES** NEED TO REPLACE THE BREAK A WAY POLES ALREADY IN GROUND WOULD BE \$3,165.00 AND THAT HE WAS 35 STREET SIGNS SHORT OF HAVING ALL SIGNS NEEDED. **CAMERON** MADE A MOTION TO GET THE GALVANIZED POLES TO USE FOR STREET SIGNS AND STOP SIGNS TO BE PUT 1 SIGN TO A POLE

BARBARA SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR MOTION PASSED.

DISCUSS AND POSSIBLY ACT UPON **EXTENDING WATER LINE FROM OAKRIDGE DOWN 1838 TO 4130** AND DOWN 4130 APPROXIMATELY 1.5 MILES TOTAL FROM OAKRIDGE. EXPLAINED TO MR. A. HOWARD ABOUT ENGINEERING STUDY WOULD HAVE TO BE DONE AT HIS EXPENSE AND I WOULD PUT ON AGENDA. COUNCIL DISCUSSED THAT MR. HOWARD WOULD NEED TO HIRE AN ENGINEER AND THAT HIS ENGINEER STUDY WOULD HAVE TO AGREED UPON BY OUR ENGINEER AND PRESENT IT ALL TO OUR COUNCIL FOR AGREEMENT AND ALL AT MR. HOWARDS EXPNSE PLUS COST OF RUNNING LINE AND MAKING TAP. COUNCIL WANTS THIS PUT ON THE **JULY AGENDA** FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION. **MUNICIPAL COURT REPORT** RONDA GAVE THE REPORT FOR MAY THE COURT COLLECTED \$6,006.20 OF THIS THE CITY KEEPS \$3,178.46 AND THE STATE GET \$1,827.74

DISCUSS AND POSSIBLY ACT UPON ALLOWING THE **COURT** TO HAVE PRE-**TRIAL HEARING BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. JUDGE FREELAND** SPOKE WITH THE COUNCIL AND INFORMED THEM OF WHAT OTHER COURTS WERE DOING AND THAT IT COULD BE POSSIBLY JULY OR AUGUST BEFORE ANY COURTS WERE HELD AND THAT HE NEEDED TO SEND A NOTICE SIGNED BY HIM AND THE MAYOR TO JUDGE LOGOMORSENO FOR APPROVAL BUT THT PRE-TRIALS COULD BE DONE BY ALLOWING 1 PERSON AT A TIME IN THE ROOM AND THAT CHIEF CARTER WOULD TAKE PEOPLES TEMP BEFORE ENTERING ROOM OTHER WOULD WAIT IN THEIR VEHICLES UNTIL CALLED IN BY THE COURT. CHIEF CARTER WILL NEED TO PURCHASE THE EQUIPMENT NEEDED FOR THIS TO HAPPEN. **BARBARA** MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT JUDGE FREELANDS RECOMMENDATIONS. **CAMERON** SECONDED THE MOTION, ALL IN FAVOR MOTION PASSED.
